

## Driving Directions to the Museum and WACO Field

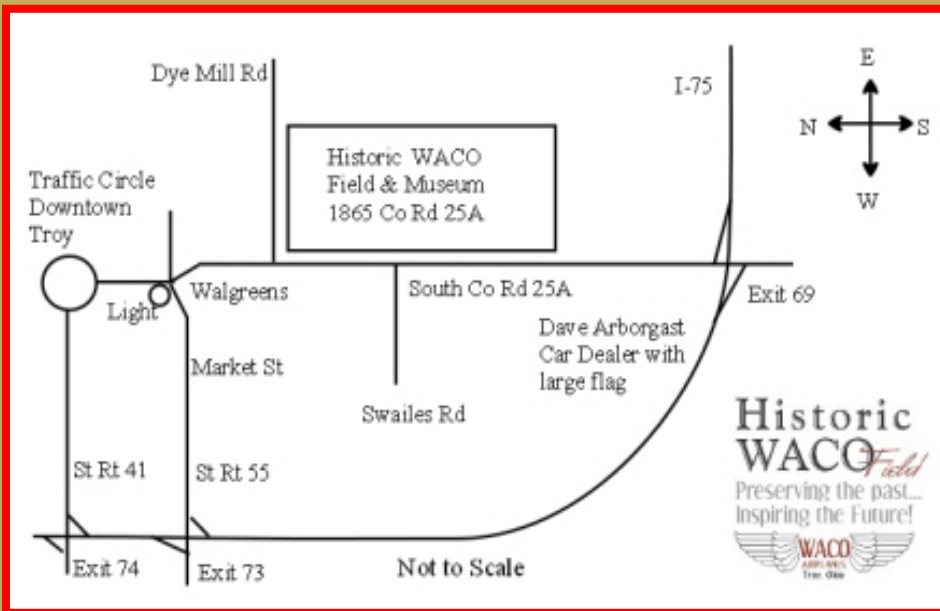
Note: **\*\*GPS Direction Finders must have South County Rd 25A to get correct directions.**

Historic WACO Field is a 77 acre public airfield and the home of the WACO Museum, located in Troy, Ohio. Troy is located in southwest Ohio, 22 miles north of Dayton, Ohio and about 10 miles north of the intersection of I-70 and I-75.

Take I-75 to Exit 69. Go North on South County Road 25A toward Troy. Historic WACO Field is located about two miles up the road on the right. Look for the historic red barn and tan hangers. There is also a sign marking the entrance.



Centrally located between 3 major airports, Troy is about an hour and a half drive to/from the airports in Indianapolis, IN, Columbus, OH, and Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky.
