

Landing Information for Historic WACO Field

HISTORIC WACO FIELD IS A PUBLIC AIRSTRIP

If our runway length is not sufficient to insure safety please contact us for special arrangements. There are longer fields nearby. We can provide ground transportation for you and/or your passenger. Your safety is our top concern.

Please note: WACO Field is an active radio control (R/C) aircraft field as well. As a general rule, if there are vehicles parked by the windsock, there may R/C operations in the airspace over the field. Please give a courteous flyby parallel to the airstrip to warn of your pending landing.
